Abilify (aripiprazole) – atypical antipsychotic used to treat schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, and irritability associated with autism. Adderall (amphetamine, dextroamphetamine mixed salts) – a stimulant used to treat ADHD. Ambien (zolpidem) – used as a sleep aid.
